

Dear members of the 115th General Members Assembly,

As mentioned in the bylaws of our association, the Audit committee is obligated to inform the General Members Assembly about the correctness of the financial situation of our association. The main focus of the Audit committee is to check whether the administration provides a realistic and correct reflection of the financial status of the association. In this letter, we, the Audit committee, as constituted at the 111th GMA on 4 September 2025, present the results of the auditing of the books during the financial year 2025-2026.

During said financial year, 6 audits have taken place. During these meetings, we have checked the financial administration and the accounts of the association on correctness and completeness. With the exception of one occasion, for these meetings, all documents were made available in time by the treasurer, Joost op 't Veld.

As with every association, these meetings bring up certain unclarities in the finances of the association, both introduced by members of the Audit Committee as well as by Joost himself. No significant shortcomings in the work of the treasurer were encountered and given feedback has been processed sufficiently. From the meetings it is clear that Joost is responsible and has a good understanding of the financial administration of Stress. His work is structured and of good quality.

Concluding, we can inform the General Members Assembly of Study Association Stress that the financial documents match with the books and give the members of Stress a correct representation on the financial year 2025-2026. Hence, we advise the General Members Assembly to approve the financial report of 2025-2026. Finally, we would like to thank Joost op 't Veld for his work as treasurer in the last year and Tristan Ettema and Maud Punte for functioning as vice-treasurer.
